## Paw Prints Pet Services LLC Pet Lodging Addendum



Paw Prints Pet Services is pleased to welcome friendly dogs with nice house manners to join our family in a home setting for Pet Lodging (also known as dog boarding and daycare). We will have multiple dogs enjoying "camp" so your dog must be social and good with other dogs and people. There are a few more requirements to make sure all dogs have an enjoyable stay.

## I agree to and understand the following conditions and terms:

- Paw Prints Pet Services makes a subjective decision to accept dogs in our pet lodging care based on a "meet and greet" behavior assessment. It is important that Client is truthful and provides accurate information on the dog's behavior and health, especially if there may be any aggression or anxiety.
- Paw Prints Pet Services reserves the right to refuse to accept a dog or to require pick up by the emergency contact for any reason, including without limitation, if the dog appears to be sick, injured, has fleas, or displays behavior issues. Please don't bring your dog if not in good health. It's not fair to the other visiting dogs!
- It is required that all dogs are current on all immunizations and vaccinations including Rabies, DHPP, Bordetella, and Canine Influenza according to veterinarian recommended standards. Lyme, and Leptospirosis vaccines are also highly recommended. All vaccinations must be administered at least 2 weeks prior to their arrival. This allows sufficient time for your dog's immune system to develop full protection and minimizes the risk of shedding any illnesses to other dogs.
- Dogs must be current on their treatment and free from contagious diseases and pests such as fleas, ticks, mites, and other parasites. If treatment is required while in the care of Paw Prints Pet Services, costs of all purchases and related fees will be paid by the Client or fully reimbursed to Paw Prints Pet Services within 14 days.
- If your dog becomes ill or injured while in the care of Paw Prints Pet Services then veterinary treatment will be offered following the terms of the Service Agreement and Veterinary Release Agreement.
- Due to the social nature of pet lodging, there are associated risks such as aggression or rough play resulting in injury, bites, scratches, or communicable infection. Client understands and agrees to all terms and conditions of the Service Agreement, including the liability provisions, and additionally Client recognizes and assumes all inherent risks and hazards and releases Paw Prints Pet Services from liability and/or treatment expense.
- Dogs must have nice house manners. This includes being potty trained without marking, pee, or poop accidents while inside. We cannot accept dogs with separation, food, toy, dog, people, or social anxieties or destructive behavior. Dogs may be confined for safety or sanitation reasons. Paw Prints does use belly wraps or doggy diapers if necessary for urinary marking or accidents. There may be additional fees if extra house cleaning or repairs are required for potty accidents or destructive behavior.
- All dogs must wear a collar with a current identification tag attached.

- Please leave dog beds and toys at home. Paw Prints is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal items. You will need to bring a collar and/or harness, a leash, and enough food and necessary medication for your dog's stay. It is recommended to provide a few extra food servings in case of travel delays.
- Dog drop-off and pickups are by appointment only, scheduled between 8 AM and 8 PM. Please be respectful of the appointment time. Otherwise, we may not be available and you will have to reschedule.
- When scheduling pet lodging reservations, we need the dates your dog will stay with us and not *your* travel dates! As mentioned above, we schedule dog arrival and pick-up appointments between 8 AM and 8 PM so if your flight lands at 8 PM, your dog will to need to stay until the next day. And, sometimes we'll need to adjust your arrival or pick-up date if your dog is lucky enough to go to our farm for the weekend. Additional pet lodging fees will apply.
- Adventures on the Farm sometimes pet lodging dogs will enjoy a bonus weekend in the country at our farm. They will be off-leash with other dogs in a country environment which brings additional risks and they may get dirty. Dogs must be trustworthy off-leash. Client will hold Paw Prints Pet Services harmless from all liability, legal, and financial consequences should the dog become lost, injured, deceased, or otherwise harmed or cause harm to people, animals, or property from being off leash.
- Remember, it is common for dogs to be tired or lethargic when arriving home. It usually means they had fun and need to catch up on some sleep!
- Intact or unaltered adult dogs are usually not accepted. Please do not bring a female dog in heat as Paw Prints cannot be held responsible for pregnancy or disruption to other dogs.

## Things to bring for pet lodging or daycare:

- Collar and/or harness with dog's name, rabies, and registration tags
- Leash (we discourage retractable or flexi leashes)
- Plenty of food with feeding instructions, a few extra portions are recommended
- Any necessary medications with instructions
- Treats or chewies
- Reminders & changes

We have plenty of dog toys, beds, bowls, and poop bags so there is no need to bring those items.
